



Highlighting:

Makes it easy for patrons to confirm that their search worked.









- OPAC Slider:
 - Show off new items in your collection
 - Click the left or right arrow to scroll through the book covers.
 - Click a book cover to see the complete record.







- Update your OPAC look:
 - Make a copy of your OPAC template.
 - Add/update images, text, links, etc.
 - Change background colors.
 - Test before making it live.
 - Designer guide and videos available.







Facets:

- Do a search.
- Make selections from the Facet panel.
- Hit Apply. Narrow search results.
- Don't have run a new search.









Widgets:

• Calendar, clock, date, map, external search box, new title list, more.










