Cataloging bibliographic record: Distinguish subfields by color and space

User Story

As a(n): **Cataloging User**

I want: **Subfields distinguished by color (as they were before the most recent enhancement) and by space in a bibliographic record**

So that: **Spelling error markings are not confusingly activated, making it easier to proofread, and so that text can be copied without the pipe and subfield letter**

EOS: Please stay tuned... we are reviewing our options. Remember that the MARC Detail Editor is a single click and will display the tag with subfields in a bold blue, in separate subfields for cut/paste without the subfield designation and with the option to spell check.

Fines/fees retention

User Story

As a(n): Circulation Admin

I want: EOS Web to have a prompt screen which asks if I want to retain fines/fees when items are checked in so lost items can be deleted

So that: the account details information remains on the patron record after items are checked in. Checking in is necessary before items can be deleted after they have been lost for a certain amount of time.

EOS: When deleting a Lost item, the Lost fines can be retained in the patron record or the patron can be relieved of the Lost fines.

To relieve the patron of the Lost fine, check in the item or change the status to Missing or Discard (check in or changing the status to Missing or Discard will check in the lost item and relieve the patron of the fine). If status is Missing, Discard or Available, the item can be deleted.

To keep the Lost fine in the patron record, change the Lost status to Claimed Returned or (claimed) Never Checked Out. This will write the fine to the patron record and unlink the item. The Claimed Returned or Never Checked Out status can then be changed to Available to delete the item.

User Story

As a(n): Admin User

I want: the user be able to go to Maintenance > Cataloging > Media Links Files and Delete multiple files

So that: unlinked Media Files can be deleted to free up storage space

There is currently no way for a user to see which uploaded Linked Media is actually actively linked to a record in EOS> I would like to be able to view which media are not linked easily and delete them in order to free up storage space for additional linked media.

Add Frequency to My Routing Info

User Story

As a(n): OPAC User

I want: the frequency of a publication (310 MARC field) added to My Routing > Add

So that: when I click on the + sign, I can see how often the publication comes

Currently, when users visit the My Routing > Add page, they can click on a + sign to see a description of the publication. This enhancement request asks for the frequency to also display in this area. The frequency of a publication can have an impact on whether a user wants to sign up, especially given today's frequent information overload.

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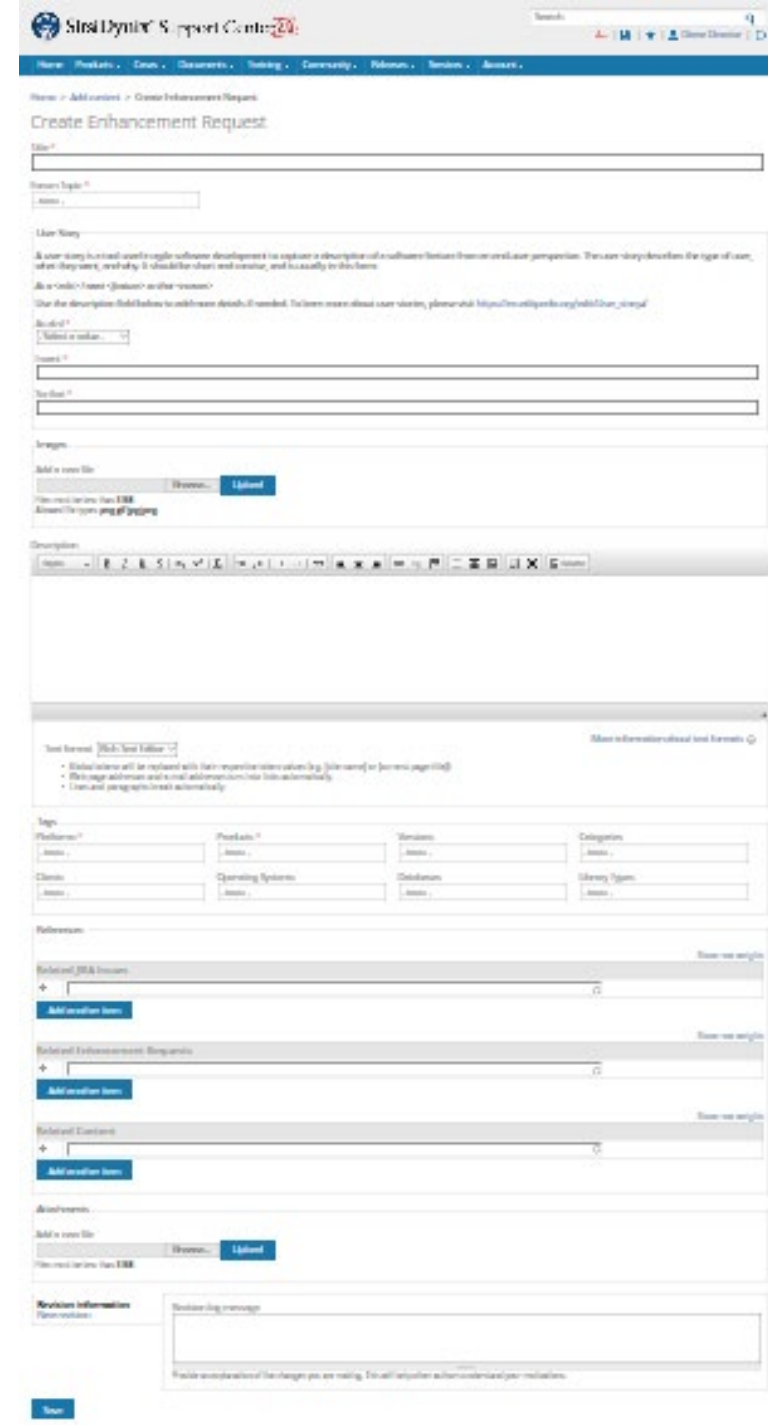

User Story

As a(n): OPAC User

I want: a "Forgot User ID?" link on the OPAC sign-in page

So that: users who don't remember their User ID, password, or both will have automated help in recovering that information, which will allow them to sign in more quickly.

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
User Story

As a(n): Circulation User

I want: to be able to make the Email address a mandatory field in patron records

So that: no Patron records are missing either the Patron's email address or else a generic library email address. There are potentially other mandatory fields that we would like to make mandatory in the Patron record.

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User Story

As a(n): Admin User

I want: EOS.Web to be able to accept data via our SAML token

So that: we no longer have to do patron updates. This capability is used with other vendors.

With other vendors we work with, we are able to pass data via our SAML token to our vendors. This data can come from any attribute in our Active Directory and can be mapped to fields within a vendors database. For example, we can map an employee ID to a patron barcode (which is what is currently done), in addition we could map patron name, email, address, etc to existing fields within the Patron record if EOS.Web can set this capability up. This would eliminate the need to import patron data on a set schedule to keep patron information current.

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User Story

As a(n): OPAC User

I want: to show the time due back as well as the date

So that: I can see what study room is available when

This is a screen shot of our old Sirsi system. I have added the arrow to show the additional information that I would like to add. I notice that when I checkout an item to a patron, the timestamp appears on the checkout screen.

User Story

As a(n): Cataloging Admin

I want: headings selected from the Authority Filter using the Add Multiple tool to maintain proper tag number

So that: the bibliographic records in my database are accurate and the Authority Filter doesn't get filled with incorrect records that can then be selected by other novice catalogers and added to other bibliographic records

Example #1: Rhode Island—Antiquities (651- Geographic Name)

In this case, the Authority Filter had two existing headings, one being Geographic and other Topical. When I selected the Geographic heading and added it to my bib record, it became a Topical Term heading.

1. Visit Authority Filter using "Add Multiple" tool in Easy MARC. Select Rhode Island—Antiquities, Geographic Name heading. [see "**AuthorityFilter...Page_1**" image]

1a. First, look at Authority record in Edit mode. Notice that "Rhode Island" and "Antiquities" are in the appropriate <a> and <x> subfields.

2. After clicking the Select button in the Authority Filter, open MARC Detail to view the Rhode Island—Antiquities subject heading I've just added. Note that it is now tagged as a 650—Topical Term, and that both elements have been dumped in the <a> subfield (however, this is likely because the existing Topical Subject heading for Rhode Island—Antiquities-- #4 in the first screenshot—had those elements all in the <a> subfield [see "**...Page_2**" image])

Example #2: Big Bend National Park (Tex.)—Animals (651- Geographic Name)

In this case, the Authority Filter contained two headings for this term. one being Geographic and the other Corporate. When I selected the Geographic heading and added it to my bib record, it became a Topical Term and created an additional (third) heading in the Authority Filter.

1. Use Add Multiple to navigate to Authority Filter. Select number 5, Big Bend National Park (Tex.)—Animals, which is a Geographic Name. Note that the only two headings for this set of terms are one for Geographic Name and one for Corporate Name

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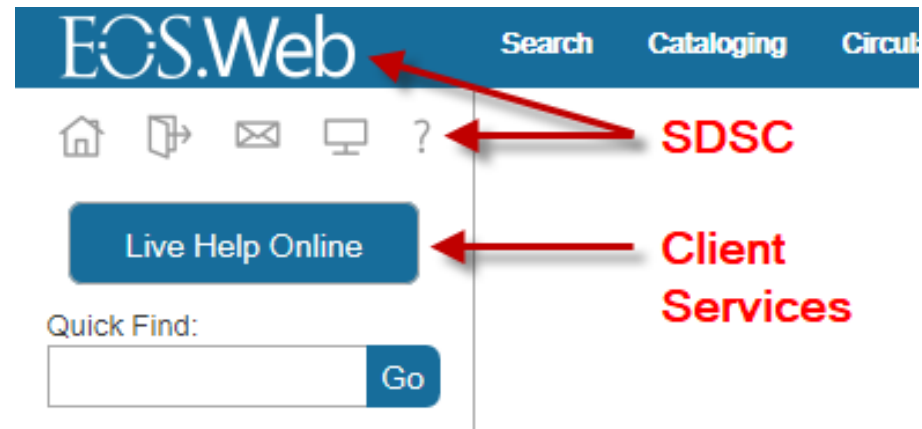
