Mobility: What is it?

- Mobile libraries meet customers where they are
- At the most basic, mobile libraries provide access to as many library resources as possible regardless of how access occurs

Device Ownership

"The vast majority of Americans – 95% – now own a cellphone of some kind. The share of Americans that own smartphones is now 77%, up from just 35% in Pew Research Center's first survey of smartphone ownership conducted in 2011....Over half now own tablet computers


What does this mean for special libraries?

"In some recent surveys of mobile users of library services, the library catalog was not the most used or desired service. Other services such as looking up library hours, reserving a study room or computer, checking out materials, paying fines, and reading electronic resources were of as much interest as searching the library catalog; in mostcases much more important. It may be especially important for special libraries to provide mobile access to user accounts, in order to view the status of checked out materials, check current awareness lists, and to obtain direct access to online resources from a mobile device."

Don't Forget Staff Training!

"Mary Alice Scherdin tested 1,600 librarians in 1992 to determine their Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI), a widely used personality test that analyzes which of the opposing traits of Extroversion/Introversion, Sensing/Intuition, Thinking/Feeling, and Judging /Perceiving determines an individual's type. She found that the majority of librarians are indeed introverts, 63 percent versus 37 percent for extroverts."
